# The Take Away

Of the 632 kindergarten students who entered the year in the intensive group, all but 99 moved up either one or two levels by the end of the year; of the 402 students who started in the strategic area, 77% of them achieved benchmark with excellent core and intervention instruction.

## Summary:

Rutherford County is one of the fastest growing school districts in Tennessee. Since the 2000-2001 school year, Rutherford County Schools has added more than 15,000 students for a total enrollment exceeding 41,000. During that time, the district has opened 17 new schools, and has completed additions/renovations at nine other schools. As the district continues to grow and change, its mission remains the same - to empower today's students to grasp tomorrow's opportunities.

### The Challenge:

With 46 schools and more than 41,000 students, Rutherford has many challenges. The district operates 25 elementary schools including 10 Title-1 funded elementary schools that receive school-wide Title I funds. There are in excess of 2,000 students that qualify as English Language Learners, and roughly 17,000 students, more than 42% of the student population, are considered economically disadvantaged. The latest estimate in 2012 for free and reduced lunch eligibility was 35.2%.

With this high rate of growth and constantly changing demographic, how could the district effectively keep up with day to day responsibilities while also ensuring that all kids continue to become better readers?

#### The Solution:

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According to Duke, it isn't about how many programs they could buy and put in the teachers' hands. Said Duke, "It was about how do we build a better teacher and then coach them with ongoing modeling, ongoing support throughout the day, and ongoing support for the kids who are most at risk."

After using DIBELS® assessments for several years, Rutherford County teachers weren't sure how to help their students who were identified as struggling readers. They began an intensive search to find the best possible way to help the students. They discovered Dr. Susan Hall's book, *I've DIBEL'd, Now What?* and then attended 95 Percent Group's public workshops. Following these steps and some research, they selected 95 Percent Group to support their implementation of RTI².

Work with Rutherford began in the fall of 2009 with a "Launch Day" for all Kindergarten and First Grade teachers from all 10 Title 1 schools.

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Support continued with training for Instructional Coaches, Principals, and Assistant Principals including webinars, school visits, and ongoing support from 95 Percent Group Consultants.

"When you look at starting implementation, there are a lot of things and a lot of moving pieces to take into account. So, my biggest piece of advice for leaders is that you have to provide clarity," Duke said. With this clarity, implementation began from the top down as a district-level initiative, and then moved to a bottom-up approach when teachers saw the swift pace of success in the classroom. Requests for 95 Percent Group products just took off. "The teachers were saying, 'We want this product!' We see what it is doing for kids in other schools – we need this product in our building," Duke said.

Recent district surveys indicated that teachers value the intensity of the lessons that have been pre-designed in the *Phonics Lesson Library*  $^{\text{TM}}$ . These lessons, combined with continued Consultant support and staff development, have allowed for continuous implementation success for Tennessee's RTI  $^2$  process.

Schofield reports that 95 Percent Group materials fit perfectly into the district's RTI<sup>2</sup> plan.
