




Professional learning matters


Improvement in intervention outcomes with an implementation program



Research has suggested that without implementation teams using clearly defined implementation methods, it takes 17 years to move approximately half of an intended new initiative into routine practice (Balas & Boren, 2000; Morris, Wooding & Grant, 2011; Bauer, Damschroder, Hagedorn, Smith, & Kilbourne, 2015)" (Perspectives on Language and Literacy, International Dyslexia Association; Fall, 2018).




